We are making plans to replace and rebuild the Sausalito Shores boat and fishing dock down by Lake Howell!

Construction should begin sometime in late spring or early summer, with the new dock having a handicapped-accessible ramp that would extend all the way to the end of the dock area with benches to sit on. It will be built with synthetic decking to withstand the weather better, and will have lights along its length.

Last chance for keys

The key locks for the main gate, RV Storage, and Boat Ramp were changed on Feb. 26, along with the push-button codes to the walk-thru entrance gates to the SSHA park area, children's playground, tennis courts, and basketball courts in March. All older keys and lock combinations are no longer valid, so it is important that you get your new code and exchange your old key for a new one at the Clubhouse on:

Wednesday, March 24th, 7 P.M. – 8 P.M.

Recall that in your boating/RV Storage rules a **lost key costs \$100**, so be sure to bring your current key to trade even for the new one at no charge to you.

Updated RV Storage and Boating Club forms will be necessary this year, so please bring the following information with you to one of the dates above: **Boat/Trailer/Motorhome manufacturer, model, license plate number, and proof of current insurance on the vehicle.** To reduce the time spent at the clubhouse, you may also print a copy of the forms from the Sausalito website (sausalitoshores.com) and complete them at home and then bring them, along with proof of insurance, to the meeting.
