Boating Club members and their immediate family members may use the Boating Club member's key/lock combination only for use with the above documented vessel. *Giving keys and/or gate combinations to any unauthorized individual is strictly forbidden and may result in suspension of the member's privileges in the Boat Club (as determined by the SSHA Board of Directors).*
- 4. SSHA members and Sausalito Condominium residents desiring to join the Boating Club must complete this application, provide proof of a Sausalito Shores or Condominium address, be current on all applicable dues, and provide proof of current registration and insurance on the above vessel and/or trailer.
- 5. Anyone using the SSHA Boat Ramp **MUST CLOSE AND LOCK THE MAIN ENTRANCE GATE and BOAT RAMP GATE IMMEDIATELY** after entering, launching or retrieving a boat, and exiting the property. For security reasons, **DO NOT LEAVE THE MAIN ENTRANCE GATE OPEN while launching or retrieving your boat!**
- 6. After launching, the towing vehicle with boat trailer attached (with current SSHA sticker affixed to trailer tongue) may be parked on the grass inside the fence under the trees between the walk-thru entrance gate and the lake. At no time are boat trailers to be unhitched from the tow vehicle and left alone in the parking area or outside the fence/main gate area. Only vehicles with boat trailers are allowed to park inside the main gate. There is no parking on any asphalt area, no parking on the grass around the Picnic Pavilion or the Clubhouse, and there is no parking along the grass path to the RV/Storage Lot. All other guests may park their vehicles (no trailers) perpendicular to the fence in the spaces provided outside the main gate area.
- 7. The boat ramp is restricted to vessels 24 feet or less in length.
- 8. One-Day Guest Pass may be requested by SSHA members for friends or relatives who live outside Sausalito Shores, but the requesting SSHA member must be present when their guest launches his/her boat and make their guest aware of all Boating Club Rules. NOTE: Members are NOT ALLOWED to give their key(s) or gate code combination to their guests!! Guest passes are provided for occasional use (once or twice a year) only. Guest Passes are free of charge to SSHA Boating Club members in good standing. Non-Boating Club members who are SSHA members in good standing, and who live or own in Sausalito Shores, may purchase Guest Passes for \$10 per day. Guest passes are valid for one day only, and must be displayed in the windshield of the tow vehicle. A temporary key to unlock the main gate and boat ramp gate will be provided to the SSHA member (if necessary), along with a Guest Pass for guest's vehicle windshield. Both key and Guest Pass must be returned at the end of the day to the issuer. Participants may obtain the contact information for obtaining a Guest Pass by checking the SSHA website at www.SausalitoShores.com.
- 9. Boats are NOT ALLOWED to be powered on or off their trailers due to the propeller thrust which undermines and destroys the concrete boat ramp. Violations will result in suspension of the member's privileges in the Boating Club and/or SSHA.
- 10. IMPORTANT NOTE: There is NO SWIMMING ALLOWED in or around the launch ramp or the boat dock areas! Alligators and snakes are common, and broken glass, cans, or other hazards could be on the lake bottom and are impossible to see. ALWAYS wear some type of deck shoes or tennis shoes to protect feet when launching and retrieving boats. REMEMBER: the boat launch ramp may be very slippery -- always use caution!!

I, the undersigned, HAVE READ AND AGREE TO ABIDE BY THE ABOVE RULES and I agree to use the SSHA boat ramp and facilities at my own risk and to indemnify and hold harmless the Sausalito Shores Homeowners Association from and against any and all claims and demands, whether for injuries to people or damage to property resulting from my use of the boat dock, boat ramp, or facilities owned by Sausalito Shores Homeowners Association. I hereby confirm I am an owner (or renter) of a Sausalito Shores home or Sausalito Condominium and confirm that the vessel I will be using has current registration and insurance. I further understand that violation of this agreement, including any one of the rules listed above, will result in the forfeiture of any and all keys and /or lock combinations, and the use of the facilities for as long as the SSHA Board of Directors deems appropriate.
