WHY ARE TREES GOOD FOR YOU?

THEY DO MORE THAN JUST SHADE YOUR YARD

IT'S COOLER NEAR A TREE

Trees absorb heat and create "microclimates" that reduce temperatures around them by as much as 10%.

TREES CUT YOUR WATER BILL

Less scorching sun on your lawn means less water evaporation and less sprinkler use.

TREES CUT YOUR AC BILL

Shade from your trees blocking the sun can reduce your power bill by up to \$1,000 a year or more, depending on use.

TREES REDUCE STRESS

Studies have shown trees can improve well-being and reduce stress and anxiety in people who regularly are exposed to them.

TREES RAISE YOUR HOME'S VALUE

A tree-lined neighborhood's homes see an up to 15% bump in value compared to areas with few trees.

COVID-19 UPDATE

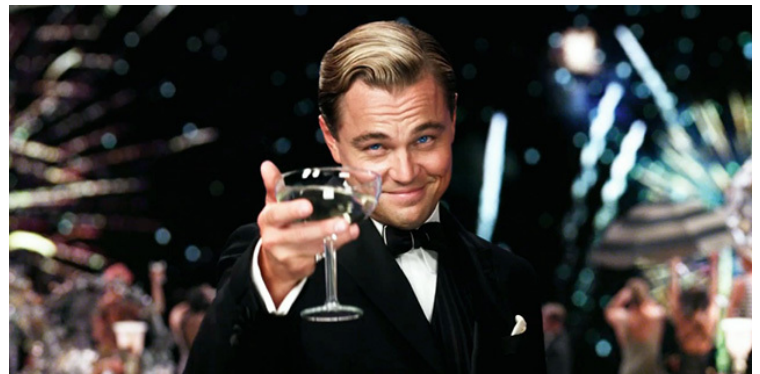
The past three months have hampered traditional SSHA activities, but that doesn't stop us from offering alternatives!
